STATE COLLEGE REGIONAL AIRPORT (SCE) BRIEFS CONGRESSMAN THOMPSON ON
PASSENGER BOARDING BRIDGE PROJECT

Benner Township, Centre County, PA - State College Regional Airport is completing the design phase for installing passenger boarding bridges and making related modifications to the terminal building. A Passenger Boarding Bridge (also known as an air bridge, jet bridge, jetway, and sky bridge as well as by other terms) allows passengers to board and disembark an aircraft without the requirement to go outside or to be exposed to the elements. Passenger boarding bridges enhance passenger convenience, safety and improve operational efficiency.

The current plan is to install two passenger boarding bridges in 2026 and two additional bridges in future years. The total project cost is estimated to be approximately \$11 Million. Centre County Airport Authority staff met with Congressman Thompson to brief him on the project and to discuss federal funding through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.
